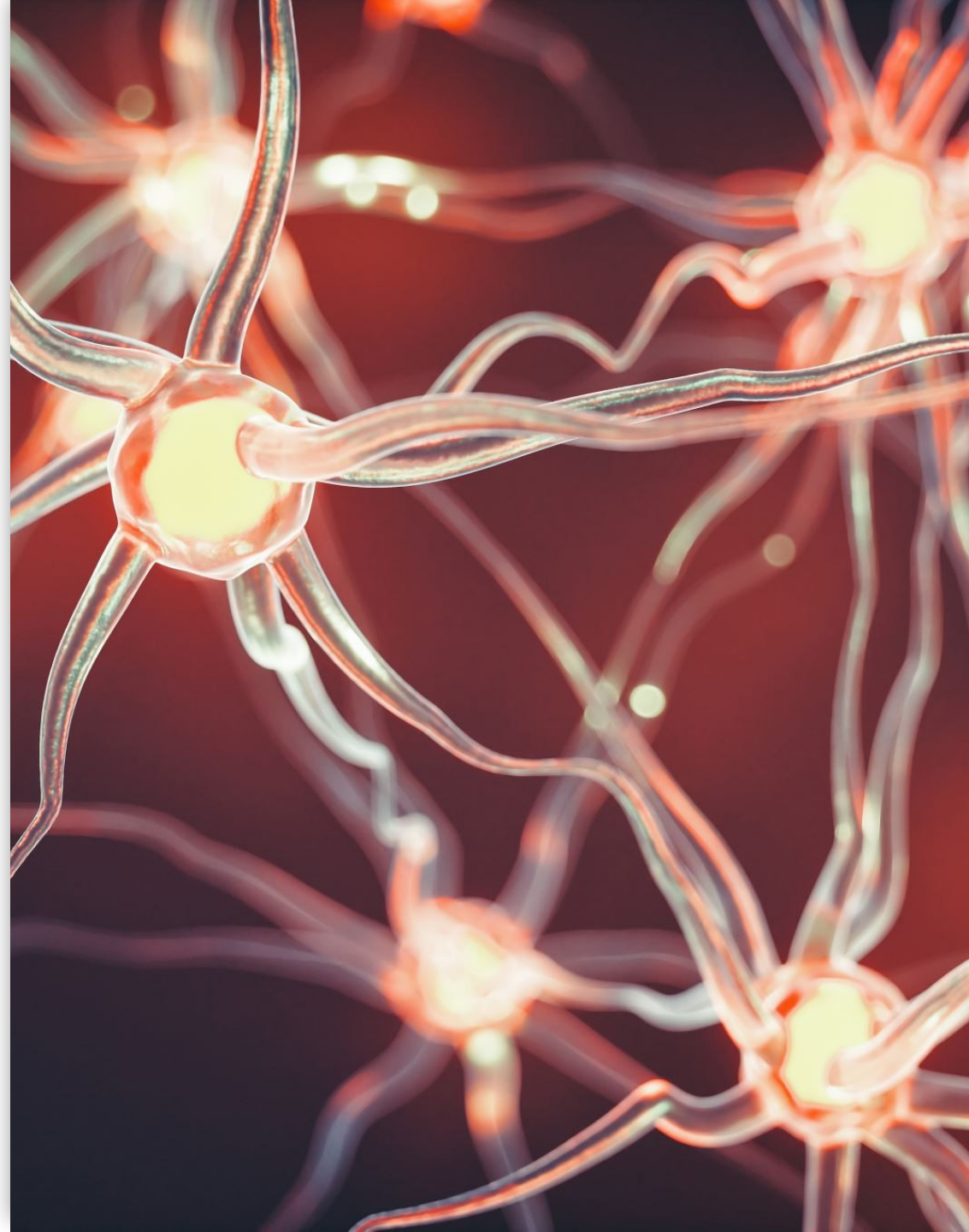

Synchronization: The Heartbeat of Innovation

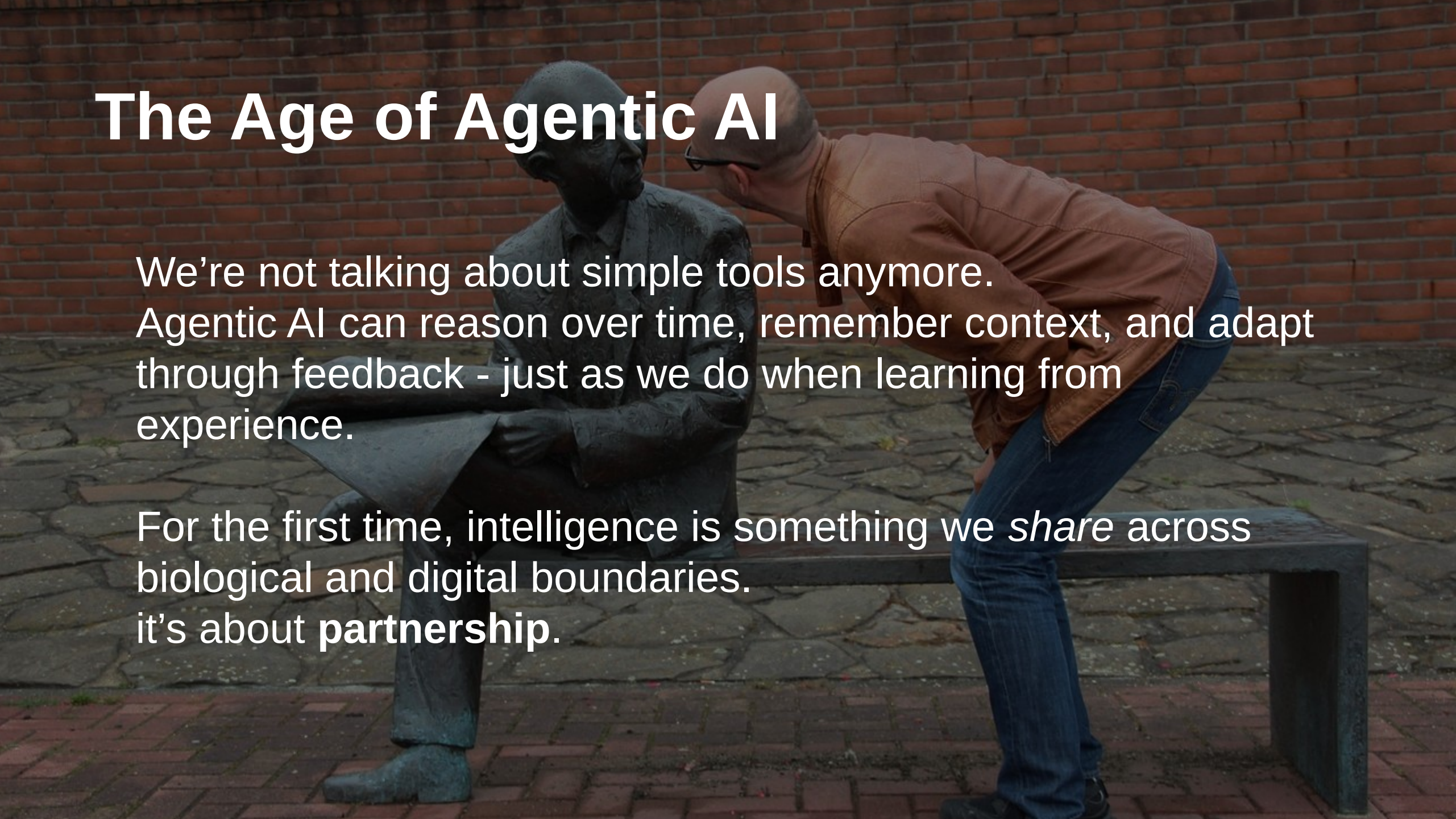
Why do fireflies flash in sync? What does this natural rhythm teach us?

Synchronization is the invisible pulse beneath breakthrough ideas, collaboration, and innovation.



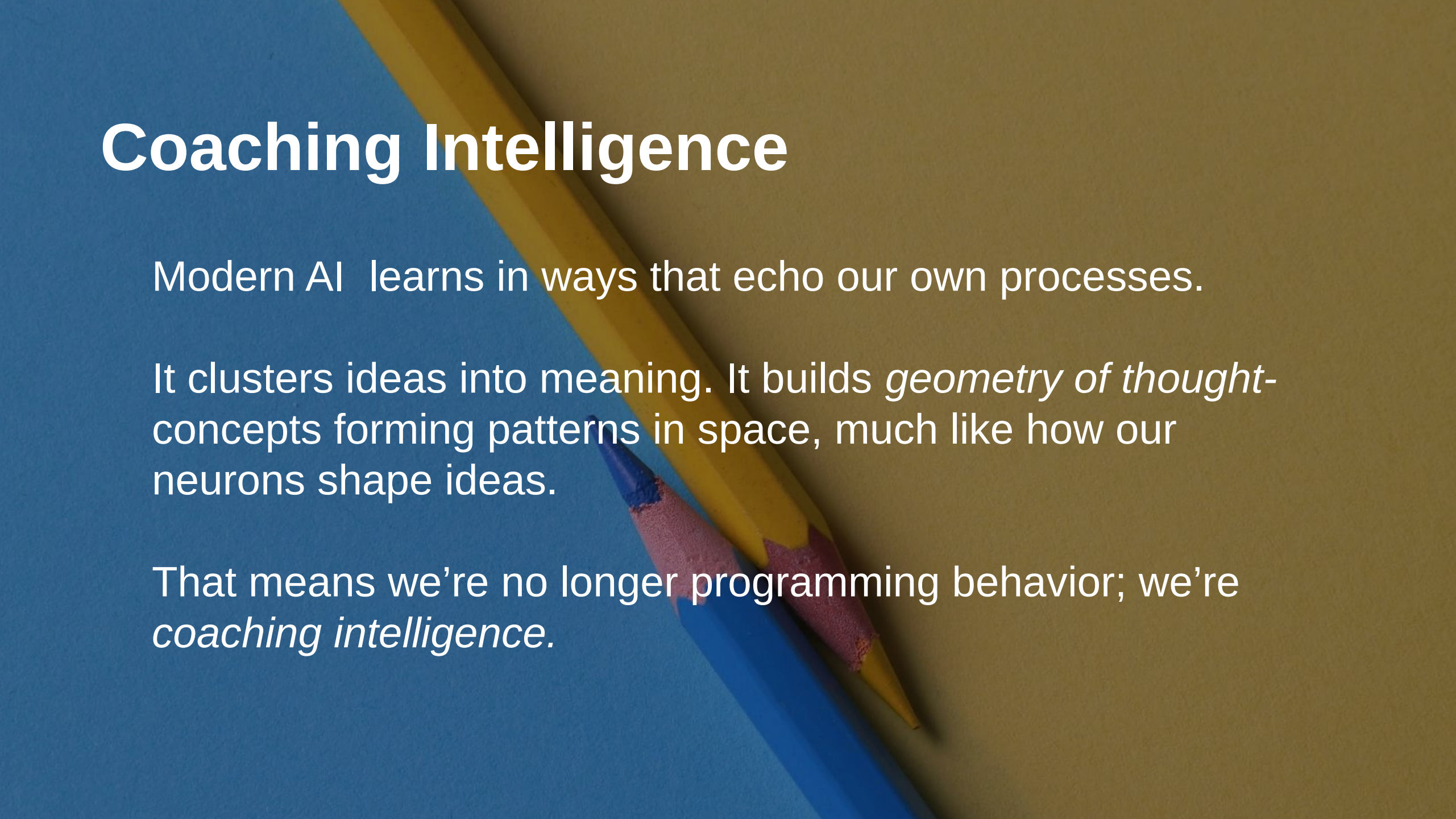
The Age of Agentic AI



We're not talking about simple tools anymore. Agentic AI can reason over time, remember context, and adapt through feedback - just as we do when learning from experience.

For the first time, intelligence is something we *share* across biological and digital boundaries. it's about **partnership**.

The more intelligent our tools become, the more human our questions must be.



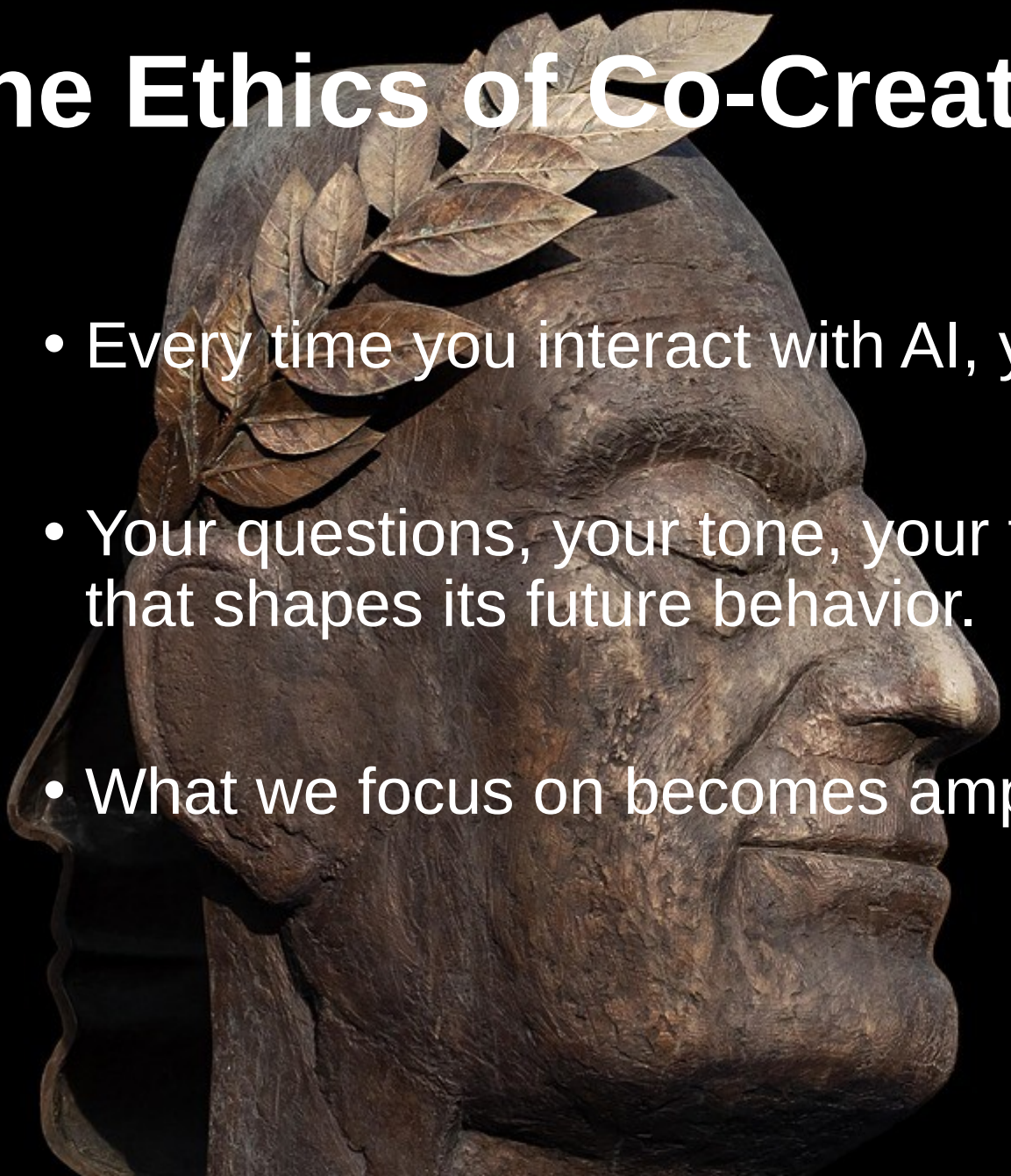
Leadership Is Rhythm, Not Command

Collaborative adaptability

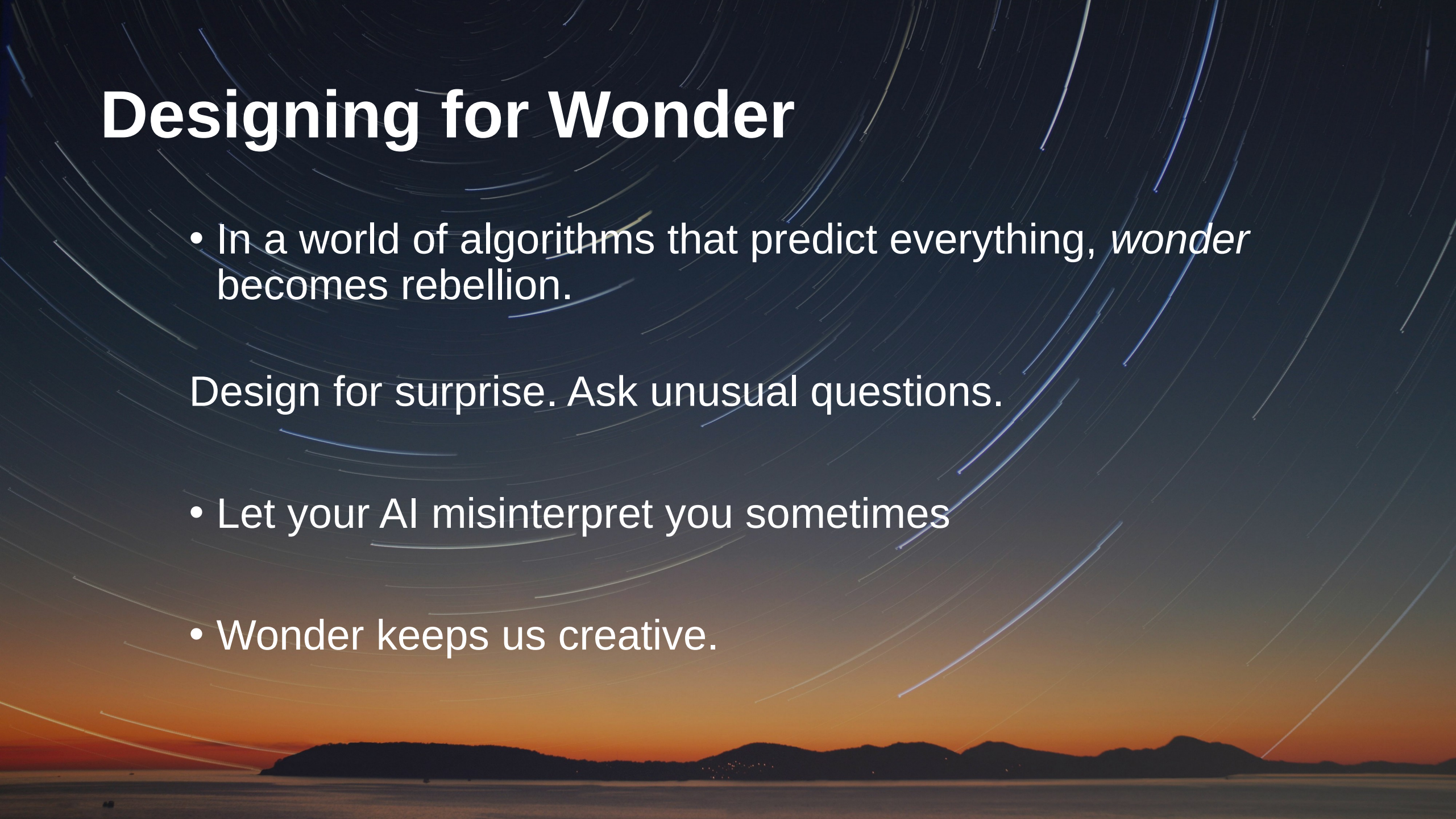
The best teams are not those with the smartest individuals, but those that can synchronize learning - human and digital - under uncertainty.

Change Ready: Stay curious. Flex your adaptability

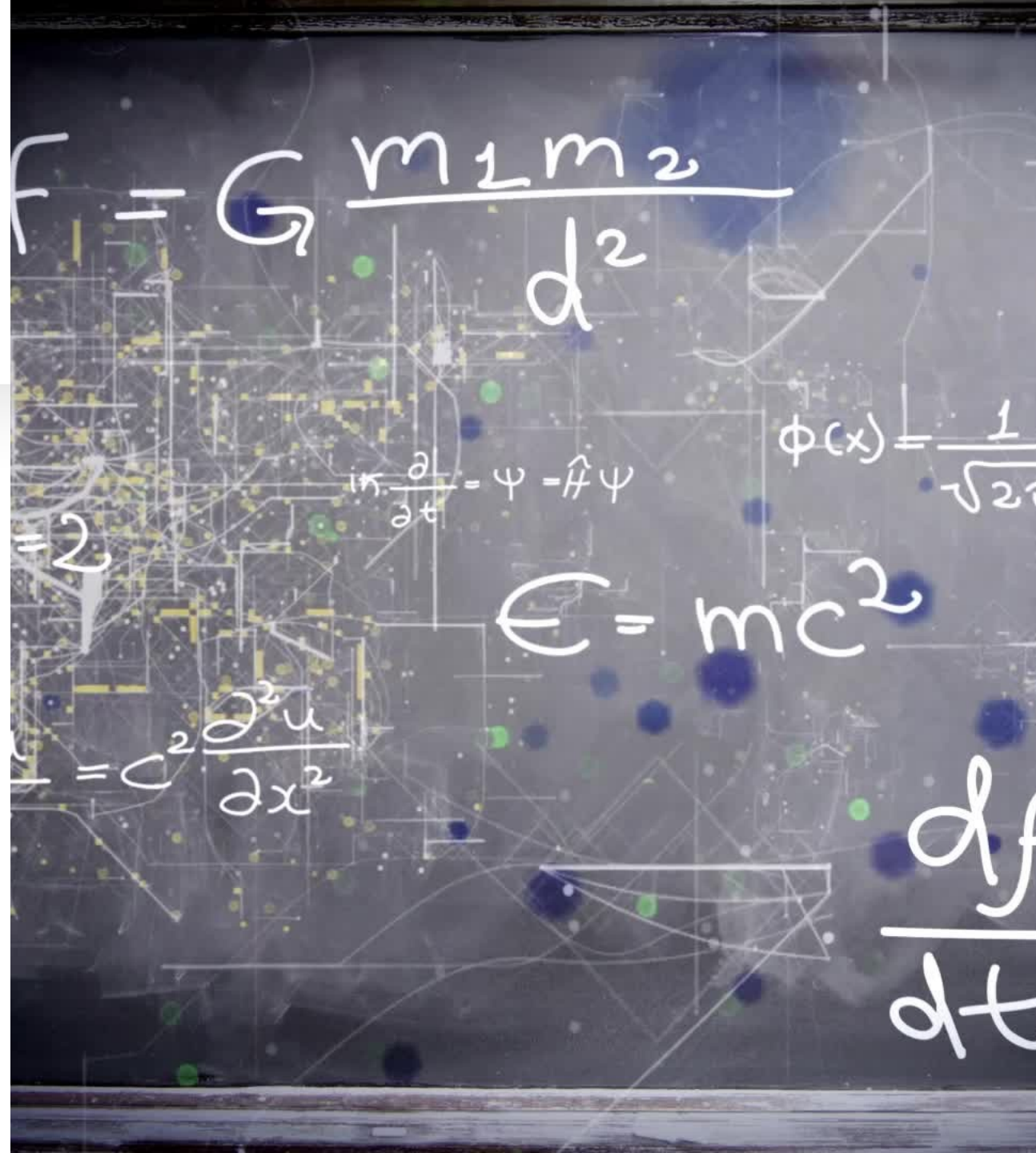
AI Ready: Partner with AI to amplify creativity.

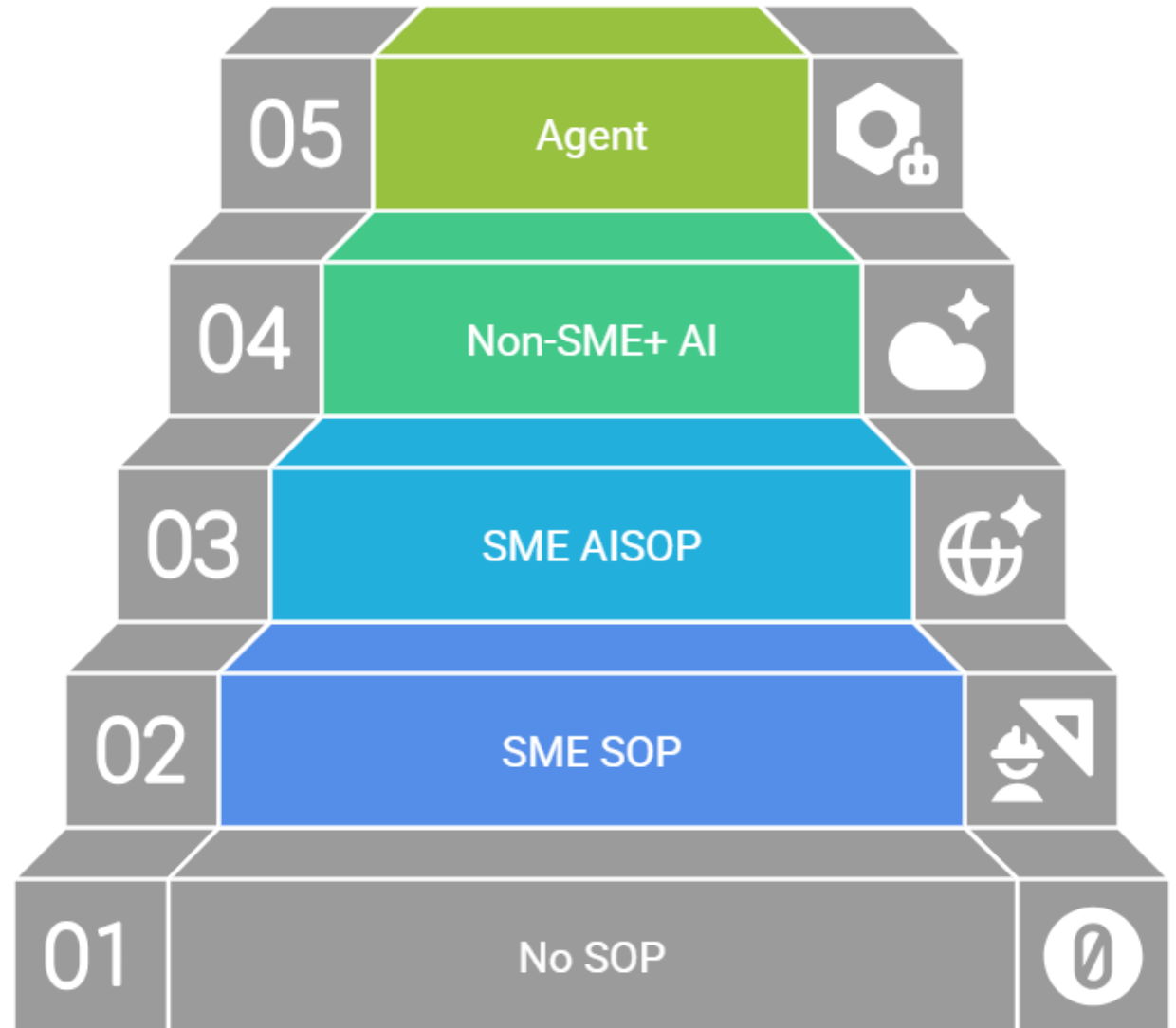
